NRS Transitions to 100% Renewable Electricity at Four Additional Locations

NRS CORPORATION has successfully transitioned four additional locations to 100% renewable energy, as part of its commitment to achieving carbon neutrality by its centennial anniversary in 2046. This initiative is a step towards increasing the ratio of renewable energy in the company's overall power consumption to 8%.

The newly transitioned locations to 100% renewable energy:

Locations that have already been transitioned:

- Head office(Kowa Hitotsubashi Building)
- Bulk logistics offices(Chiba, Gunma, Niigata, Nagoya, Osaka, Kitakyushu)
- Kumamoto Branch

The effect of reducing CO₂ emission is expected to be approximately 380ton per year, which is equivalent to approximately 2.7% of the domestic Group's total CO₂ emissions (Scope 1+2).
